

B.E./B.Tech. Candidates (First Year)

1. Government Quota Admission

Admissions through the government quota are handled by Tamil Nadu Engineering Admissions (TNEA), conducted by DOTE, Chennai.

Qualifying Examination and Eligibility

A pass in the HSC (Academic: both +1 and +2) or its equivalent with a minimum average percentage as given below.

Domicile: Candidates must satisfy the domicile requirements of Tamil Nadu (residents or studied in Tamil Nadu).

Admission Procedure

1. **Registration:** Apply on line on the TNEA website.
2. **Certificate Verification:** Upload required documents online or attend a TNEA facilitation center (TFC) for verification.
3. **Merit List Preparation:** TNEA prepares a merit list based on the candidate's marks in PCM (no entrance test).

4. Counseling

- a. Online counseling is conducted.
- b. Candidates select colleges and courses based on their ranks and availability.
- c. Seat Allotment: Seats are allotted, and candidates must confirm admission by paying the requisite fees.

5. Documents Required

- a. Class 10, 11 and 12 mark sheets.
- b. Transfer Certificate (TC).
- c. Community Certificate (for reserved categories).
- d. Nativity Certificate (if applicable).
- e. Income Certificate (for fee concessions).
- f. Passport size photo
